**Action:** Lloyd Twaites to complete introduction article for the Assayers Program web page and send it to Elaine Woo for the BCIT website.

**Action:** Lloyd Twaites to complete an article on the Assayers Program for the Northern Miner with assistance from Keith Errington and Terry Suen and to check with the Northern Miner if there are any limitations to article size.

**Action:** Lawrence Ng (ASL-Chemex) assist Mac Chaudhry with preparation and analysis of examination test samples for calcium and magnesium. Cominco, Bondar Clegg and Acme to also help with check analysis of test samples.
